



Ski tour Kreuzköpfl, 2.094 m

Details of the tour:

Altitude difference: 1.280 hm

Walking time: 3,5 hours

Starting point: 5672 Fusch Glocknerstraße

Maximum steepness: 30 degrees

Touring time: December - March

Highlight: Combination with Kühkarlkopf possible.

Route: From Fusch on the road to the Sulzbachtal at turn 5 straight on to the bridge then follow the Almweg to the left until the turn-off Kammerer Hochalm. From here turn right up the alpine path to the Kammerer Hochalm. Continue across free slopes in a westerly direction to the ridge and then in a northerly direction to the summit. After the summit rest, it is still worthwhile to ascend in an easterly direction over the ridge to the Kühkarlkopf.

Descent: Descent as ascent. If avalanche safety permits, 50 m below the Kammerer-Hochalm cross the slope through the forest to the open areas of the Badhausalm to the Sulzbachhochalm and further down to the Sulzbachgrundalm.
