



Ski tour Schusterkogel, 2.208 m

Details of the tour:

Altitude difference: 1.100 hm

Walking time: 4 hours

Starting point: Glemmtal valley head

Tour time: December - May (only with stable snow conditions!)

Highlight: View of the Wilder Kaiser.

Route: Ascent from the bridge on the goods road southwards for about 2 km into the Vogelalmgraben to the Saalhofalm. A few meters later at the mouth of a small side ditch westward up over free slopes to a kettle (small lake), over a short steep step to the upper edge of the Stefflkar and to the summit.

Alternative: From the Saalhofalm continue for a good 2 km through the ditch, then westward to the Stefflalm, through a hollow to a flat section and now northward through the Stefflkar directly to the summit.

Descent: as ascent.
