



Ski tour Zirmkogel, 2.215 m

Details of the tour:

Altitude difference: 1.025 hm

Walking time: about 2,5 hours

Starting point: From Bruck Fusch-Zell am See Schüttdorf in the direction of Niedernsill, turn right at the village of Steindorf and continue on the goods road to the former Jausenstation Hochprack.

Maximum steepness: 30 degrees

Tour time: entire winter

Highlight: View from the summit to the Hohe Tauern and Kitzbühel Alps.

Route: From Hochprack on a forest road heading NE, shortly after crossing the Steinbachgraben turn left and on a goods road to the forest border, past the Katzsteinalm and the Gitschalm, over beautiful ski terrain heading N, keep slightly left to the refuge at the Klammcharte and over the SE ridge to the summit of the Zirmkogel (2.215 m). Descent: As ascent.
